


SEWING INSTRUCTIONS FOR OTENKO PLUSHIE

Boktai (GBA)

Lunar Knights
(DS/Toasty)

Blue for

Height without petals and stem: about 6" (16cm)
Measure around the body: about 22.5" (57cm)

Tools & Materials

- Tracing paper (optional)
- Sewing kit (needle, thread, scissors, etc.)
- Fabric marking tool (Frixion pens work great)
- Yellow fabric (fleece is an easy choice)
- Felts
 - Orange (petals/cheeks)
 - Light-green (stem and leaves)
 - White (eyes)
 - Blue and Black (for LK Otenko)
- Cotton for stuffing
- 12" (30cm) thicker wire (for stem) (optional, bend the both ends for safety)

Making Steps

1. Choose your Otenko and print the pattern on Letter or A4 size paper. Set your printer to [Actual Size] or 100% scale to fill the page. Make sure the scale bar on the printout matches your ruler.
2. Trace the pattern shapes onto tracing paper, or print two copies and cut them out. Be careful of overlapping pieces.
3. Transfer the shapes and guide marks onto the back of the fabric and felt. Patterns do not include a seam allowance. Add 1/2" (1cm) seam allowance before cutting out the body and nose pieces. Watch the number of pieces and their left/right orientation.
4. Prepare [FACE], [SIDE], and [STEM] parts separately. For LK Otenko, stitch the eye parts together as well. [FACE]: Make the mouth first, then sew the two front body panels together. Position the eyes and mouth. [SIDE]: Insert the petals into the slits and sew them from the back. The top petal should be sewn across both side panels. [STEM]: Embroider (Boktai) or fold-in and stitch (LK) the leaf details first. Insert the leaves into the stem slits and sew them in place. Sew up the stem closed (with stem-base), while wrapping the wire if desired.
5. Sew the two back body panels together, inserting the stem as you sew. For Boktai Otenko, position the stem at the center of the back. Sew tightly to the body's seam allowance. For LK Otenko, stem position is halfway between the center and bottom of the body. Thread the stem through the stem-base and sew tightly to the body's seam allowance. Then sew the stem-base to the body.
6. Sew the [FACE] and [SIDE] panels together, then attach the cheeks. Join the front and [STEM] parts.
7. Stuff with plenty of cotton before sewing the seam closed. To remove lint, gently tap the surface with adhesive tape. Remove all pins and markings, then hug your Otenko!
