


SEWING INSTRUCTIONS FOR OTENKO PLUSHIE

Version 2.0
ENGLISH

◆◆◆ For Manga (Comic version) Otenko ◆◆◆



Height without petals and stem: about 6" (16cm)
Measure around the body: about 22.5" (57cm)

Tools & Materials

- Tracing paper (optional)
- Sewing kit and fabric marker
- Yellow fabric (fleece is an easy choice)
- Felts Cotton for stuffing
- Red-orange (petals • cheek • eyelash)
- Light-green (stem • leaves)
- White (eyes • mouth)
- Red-brown (for irises)
- Embroidery threads
- Wires (optional)
- 12" (30cm) thicker wire for stem
- Two 8" (20cm) wires for leaves
(Bend both ends with a plier for safety)

Making Steps

PREPARATION

1. Print the pattern on Letter or A4 size paper. Set your printer to [Actual Size] or 100% scale to fill the page. Make sure the scale bar on the printout matches your ruler.
2. Trace the pattern shapes onto tracing paper, or print two copies and cut them out. Be careful of overlapping pieces.
3. Transfer the shapes and guide marks onto the back of the fabric and felt.

Patterns do not include a seam allowance. Add 1/2" (1cm) seam allowance before cutting out the body and nose pieces. Watch the number of pieces and their left/right orientation.

BACK & STEM

↪ Double Running Stitch recommended

4. Embroider the leaf details. Fold each leaf in the center and stitch from the back. Wrap the wire inside if desired, leaving the stem-end of the wire exposed.
5. Insert the leaves into the stem slits and sew them from the back. Make a small loop in the stem wire and securely fix the leaf wires to it.
6. Sew the stem-bottom, then sew up the stem while stuffing with cotton. Attach the stem-base to finish.
7. Sew the two back panels of body together. Securely sew the completed stem and stem-base onto the center of the back.

SIDE & PETALS

8. Fold and baste (temporary stitch) the edges of all petals.
9. Insert the petals into the slits and sew them from the back side. The top petal should be sewn across both side panels.

FRONT & FACE

↪ Back Stitch recommended for teeth and eyebrows

10. Prepare the face parts. Embroider the teeth onto the mouth. Sew the irises onto the eyes. And sew the nose parts together. Add highlights to the eyes with Satin Stitch if you like:
11. Sew the two front panels of body together. Insert petal [D] into the slit and sew it in place.
12. Attach the mouth and eyes to the face. Embroider the eyebrows, then sew the nose on while stuffing it.



ASSEMBLY

13. Sew the [FRONT] and [SIDE] parts together, then sew the cheeks and eyelashes in place.
14. Sew the [BACK] to the body assembly. Stuff the body with plenty of cotton before closing.
15. To remove lint, gently tap the surface with adhesive tape. Remove all pins and markings, then hug your Otenko!
